As a group member you will have an important role to play in our district. You know yourself and the communities you're part of best. Help us get it right for all communities by telling us whether what we deliver through our Stronger Communities is working or not. You will make a difference to the way we deliver services for communities across the District by helping us reach the maximum number of people, so all communities can really benefit from our activities.

The District wide Stronger Communities Partnership Board is looking for **25 energetic, up and coming emerging leaders** who are **open-minded** to join **People Together**. People Together is a **powerful community** that **advises** and **influences** what **decisions** are made in the Partnership and **how** services and activities will be **delivered**.

**People Together** supports the *Stronger Communities Partnership Board* in achieving the District's vision where people living and working in Bradford District all **Get Along, Get Involved, Get On** and **Feel Safe**. Members will be the anchor that will keep our work grounded, and the connection between local people and services.

The roles are unpaid voluntary positions. You will be reimbursed for travel, phone and other reasonable expenses so you won't be out of pocket. You will be paired with a **Project Support Officer** who will **support you** in this **exciting** role.

You **must live in Bradford District** and be willing to commit to the role for a **minimum of one year**.

#### What you will do

As a member you will get involved in a **wide range** of activities. You will get to meet different types of people, build new friendships and attend some incredible social events. You will learn from each other and even learn new things about yourself!

In addition to developing your skills as a leader, you will get access to a whole range of development opportunities from Social Media and Critical Thinking training, to talking to people about their opinions on our campaigns and work. You will;

- Meet as a group once every three months for 3-4 hours.
- Help plan, deliver and attend events
- Design activities and services with professionals.
- Talk to local people to gather their views and opinions on what we deliver and the campaigns we run.
- Attend training days to learn new skills and develop existing ones.
- Share positive messages and stories on social media.
- Tell people what we've learned so far and share it with the people you know.
- Work with us to find solutions to local problems.
- Tell people about what we are doing.
- Take part in Participatory Budgeting and Panels to award funding.
- Encourage people to join our wider "Bradford for Everyone Network"
- Seven group members will join the Stronger Communities Partnership Board
